CYNTHIA (4) carries a small fish tank, home to two small turtles, into the room. She sets the tank down on the floor next to the toilet.

CYNTHIA

Adventure time!

CYNTHIA picks the first turtle up in her hand and drops it into the toilet bowl.

The TURTLE looks up at CYNTHIA, swimming in the toilet water, just as she drops the second one in to join it.

CYNTHIA pressed the flush down and the sound of the flushing toilet fills the room. CYNTHIA picks up the tank and leaves the room carrying it in both hands.

EXT. ROSS FAMILY HOME - LATER

CYNTHIA sits down by a gutter drain pipe and stares at the hole.

INT. LOUNGE ROOM OF THE ROSS FAMILY HOME - SAME TIME

FELICITY (25), Cynthia's mother, walks past the pet tank sitting on a display cabinet. She does a double take and walks over to the tank, inspecting it.

FELICITY

(shouting)

Honey?

BRIAN (26), Cynthia's father, rushes into the room.

BRIAN

What is it?

FELICITY

Where are Grover and Telly?

BRIAN walks over to the tank and inspects it himself. The tank is filled with water, but is also devoid of life.

BRIAN
I don't know. Where's
Cynthia?

FELICITY
She was playing in her room
last I saw her.

INT. CYNTHIA'S BEDROOM - SHORTLY AFTER

BRIAN ducks his head into the room, but there is no one inside.

INT. HALLWAY - CONTINUOUS

BRIAN looks up and down the hall.

BRIAN
Cynthia?

There is no response.

EXT. ROSS FAMILY HOME - SHORTLY AFTER

BRIAN walks out the back door and finds CYNTHIA sitting on the grass near the corner of the house.

BRIAN
What are you doing, Cynth?

CYNTHIA
Hi, Daddy. I'm waiting for
Grover and Telly to come home
from their adventure.

CYNTHIA continues to look intently at the drain pipe. BRIAN moves closer and sits down beside CYNTHIA. He looks at the pipe, too.

BRIAN
What kind of adventure?

CYNTHIA
They're exploring the pipes
inside our house! I hope they
bring me back some chocolate
from the gift shop.

BRIAN
Cynthia... how did they get
into the pipes?

CYNTHIA
I flushed them down the
toilet, of course.

BRIAN stares blankly at CYNTHIA. He looks back at the pipe. And then back to CYNTHIA again.

BRIAN stands and then moves back inside the house.

INT. LOUNGE ROOM OF ROSS FAMILY HOME - SHORTLY AFTER

FELICITY sits on the sofa with her feet up.

BRIAN enters the room, distracted.

FELICITY
Did you find her?

BRIAN looks up at FELICITY

BRIAN
Huh? Oh, yeah.

FELICITY
And the turtles?

BRIAN
She flushed them down the
loo.

FELICITY is speechless.

BRIAN (CONT'D)
Apparently she thinks they're
going on an adventure... and
will stop at a gift shop on
their way back to her.

FELICITY cracks a smile.

FELICITY
You know where she got that
idea from?

BRIAN shakes his head, confused.

FELICITY
My Mom. When she drove out
here for the summer.

BRIAN sits down on the sofa next to FELICITY. They face each other.

BRIAN

Ah, yes. She did like to help Cynthia imagine up adventures for them to go on. But the gift shop?

FELICITY

Remember how she stopped at a gift shop in every state from Florida to here to get something for Cynth?

BRIAN smiles and nods.

BRIAN

I guess she's just missing her Grandma. But what are we going to do about the turtles?

FELICITY

Just let me deal with that.

EXT. ROSS FAMILY HOME - LATER

FELICITY watches CYNTHIA watch the pipe from her place, standing by the back door. After a few moments, she walks over to CYNTHIA and sits down next to her.

FELICITY

Honey?

CYNTHIA still doesn't take her eyes off the pipe.

CYNTHIA

Yes, Mommy?

FELICITY

Grover and Telly... they're not going to end their adventure here.

CYNTHIA turns her head to look at FELICITY.

CYNTHIA

How do you know, Mommy? Is there another exit?

FELICITY

Well... I suppose you could look at it that way. Honey, your turtles... their adventure has taken them elsewhere.

CYNTHIA

Where?

FELICITY

Remember when you played pirates with Grandma?

CYNTHIA

Yes! Oh my goodness, that was so much fun. Like when she made me a pirate hat and when she let me drive the ship and then when we made you walk the plank! But then... then she said the ship had to take her away from me.

FELICITY

That's right, honey. Do you remember where Grandma told you the ship was sailing to?
